



## HOW TO FIND US

Civic Voice is based at the 'heritage hub' located in: **The Coffin Works, 13-15 Fleet Street, Jewellery Quarter, Birmingham, B3 1JP.**

You can contact us on: 0121 792 8177.

We are 10 mins' walk from Birmingham city centre, at the edge of the Jewellery Quarter. See overleaf for directions if travelling by train or visit [www.coffinworks.org/directions](http://www.coffinworks.org/directions) for more details about getting to us and parking.

**Please note: there are currently road closures and road/footpath diversions around Paradise Circus.**

**On arrival at The Coffin Works:** Please use the Newman Brothers Coffin Works museum entrance. If the museum is closed, walk to the left of the museum (as you are facing it) and go through the covered gates (cobble pathway). Use the intercom and buzz for 'Coffin Works Meeting Room' or 'Birmingham Conservation Trust HERITAGE HUB'.



## **Travelling by Train**

Our nearest train stations are Birmingham New Street and Snow Hill. The Jewellery Quarter metro is a little bit further away.

If you have difficulty walking, there is a taxi rank at Birmingham New Street station.

### **Birmingham New Street**

We are a 10-15 minute (slightly uphill) walk from Birmingham New Street. Exit the station via the Stephenson Street entrance, signposted 'Victoria Square' or 'New Street'. Cross over the tramlines (Stephenson Street) and walk up the short hill (Lower Temple Street). Turn left onto New Street and walk towards Victoria Square. Head towards the Council House at the top of the steps/ramp. There are currently road closures and road/footpath diversions around Paradise Circus so follow signs for Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery (BMAG) or Jewellery Quarter. Turn right onto Cornwall Street and left onto Newhall Street. Cross over at Great Charles Street Queensway, a dual carriageway located at the rear of BMAG. From there, head straight on. Carry on walking for around 50 metres and Fleet Street is the second road on the left. Newman Brothers is located at the top end of the road (on the left).

### **Birmingham Snow Hill**

If travelling from Snow Hill Station, this is roughly another 10 minute walk. Leave the station and turn right on to Colmore Row. Head down that road for approximately 300 metres, past the cathedral on your left, until you reach traffic lights. Cross over on to Newhall Street and turn right. Head down Newhall Street until you reach Great Charles Street Queensway. Cross over and head straight on. Carry on walking for around 50 metres and Fleet Street is the second road on the left. Newman Brothers is located at the top end of the road (on the left).
