APPLICATION GUIDANCE

About the Marsh First World War Commemoration Award

The award will celebrate the efforts of individuals throughout England who have engaged in activities to commemorate the events of the First World War and the people involved 100 years ago.

- Stage 1** Complete & submit application form by September 24th 2017
- Stage 2** All nominations will be individually assessed by a judging panel from Marsh Christian Trust.
- Stage 3** The winner will be announced at the Civic Voice Convention on October 21st 2017 in Wakefield. All finalists are invited to attend.

Who is eligible?

- Individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to voluntary or community activities dedicated to commemorating the First World War, including (but not exclusive to) recording, conserving or protecting war memorials.
- Individuals nominated must be giving their time as unpaid volunteers.
- Projects that have received grants or public funding are accepted.
- England only.

Your nomination should give details of the activity or project with which the individual has been involved and why their contribution is considered to be outstanding. How have they gone above and beyond? What has been achieved as a result of their contribution?
