

## REGULATIONS OF CIVIC VOICE

The following are the Regulations of Civic Voice as referred to in the Articles of Association. The relevant date of approval by the Board is indicated for each Regulation.

### **Associate membership (Article 15.1) [Board approval 9 March 2010]**

Civic Voice shall have the following categories of associate membership:

(1) Regional and other groupings of civic societies

Such groupings will need some form of memorandum of agreement or constitution. They shall not have voting rights but shall be able to:

- use the name or logo of Civic Voice
- access relevant partnerships or other benefits of membership developed by Civic Voice
- attend meetings (including the AGM)
- participate in Civic Voice's campaigns
- receive communications from Civic Voice

(2) Other

These categories of membership do not have voting rights or the ability to use the name or logo of Civic Voice but shall be able to

- access relevant partnerships and other benefits of membership developed by Civic Voice
- attend meetings (including the AGM)
- participate in Civic Voice's campaigns
- receive communications from Civic Voice.

[For information and not forming part of the Regulations the cost of membership agreed by the Board on 9 March 2010 is as follows:

- regional and other groupings of civic societies £50
- individual £10
- voluntary sector £50
- public sector £250
- town and parish council £50
- corporate £250 guideline minimum
- reciprocal n/a
- honorary. n/a]

**Appointment of Civic Panel trustee (Article 33.3) [Board approval 14 September 2010]**

The Civic Panel Trustee shall be appointed by:

1. inviting nominations from the Civic Panel
2. the Chair considering such nominations and making a proposal to the Board
3. the Board appointing the Chair's proposal if it sees fit or requesting further nominations.
