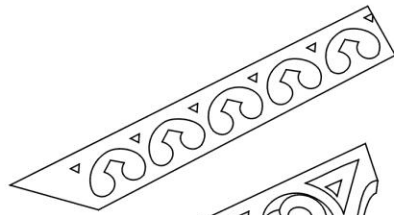

Bargeboards

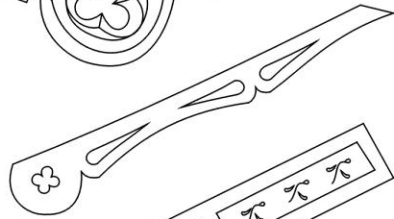
Bargeboards are the decorative wooden trims on the gable end of a roof. Only a section of each board is illustrated here. The paint colour of each board is given.

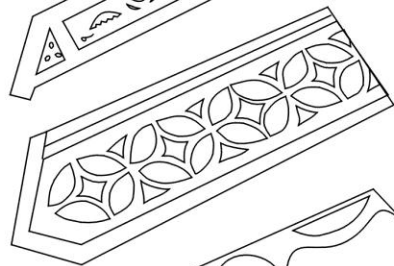

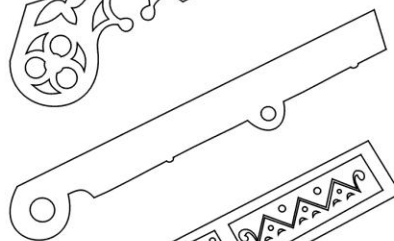

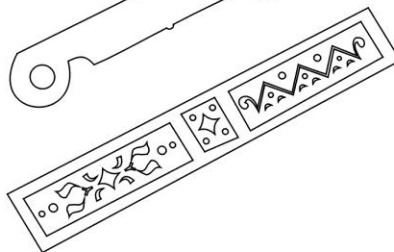
